Dr. B. Sudarshan is currently teaching in the department of Political Science, at Nizam College, Osmania University, Hyderabad. He holds a Ph. D in Political Science from Osmania University in Hyderabad for his work on ***Dalit Representation in Panchayati Raj Institutions: A Case Study of Medak District.***

He published a book in 2017 titled “*Panchayati Raj Practice in Indian Village*” established the argument that to understand the status of elected representatives, particularly the Dalit and women representatives at the Gram Panchayat level, one must understand the social character of Indian village. The author brought the theoretical ideas about Indian village, propounded by the western scholars of early colonial times and also the and conceptions of Dr. B. R. Ambedkar, M. K. Gandhi, J. L. Nehru and about Indian village and their reconstruction during the freedom struggle. Primarily the work dwells in to the limits of and the struggles of the Dalit elected representatives at the grassroots. Further, he published articles in National and International journals like ***Commonwealth Journal of Local Governance***, The journal is auspice by the Commonwealth Local Government Forum (UK), edited by Cardiff University (UK), and published by the UTS Centre for Local Government and ***Local Government Quarterly*** by MHRD, India. He published more than hundred articles in various Telugu news papers, magazines. He edited books by his academic research and his field work as a rights activist. He edited two books entitled ***Birth without Birthday, Indus Versus Aryan*** and is an author of one book entitles ***Dalita Samskruthika Rajakeeyalu*** (Dalit Cultural Politics) in Telugu. He contributed chapters for the text books published by Dr. B. R. Ambedkar Open University and Telugu Academy, Telangana State. His areas of research are Political Representation, Democratic Decentralisation (Panchayati Raj), Social exclusion, Dalit rights, Social and Cultural movements in India, Government and politics of Telangana.

He was earlier worked as a journalist for Telugu daily ‘Sakshi’ presently an associate editor for monthly magazine *Bahujana Keratalau*, dedicated to subaltern politics, and also a socio-political analyst for Telugu news channels.
